## NOTICE OF RACE

### RS Tera Open Meeting Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2017

- 1) **Organising Authority** : The organising authority is Frensham Pond Sailing Club.
- 2) **Venue** : Frensham Pond Sailing Club, Pond Lane, Churt, Surrey, GU10 2QA.  
Races will be sailed on Frensham Great Pond.
- 3) **Rules** : The meeting will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, the prescriptions of the RYA and the RS Tera Class Rules except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
- 4) **Eligibility** : Eligible boats are RS Teras with either the Pro or Sport rig. Helms must be members of the Class Association and be insured for third party liabilities of at least £1,000,000.
- 5) **Entry** : A completed Entry Form together with the race entry fee must be posted to the address shown on the form to arrive by 5<sup>th</sup> June and will be acknowledged by email. There is a limit to the number of boats that can enter and if this is reached prior to 5<sup>th</sup> June then no further entries will be accepted. Entries made after 5<sup>th</sup> June will only be accepted at FPSC's discretion.
- 6) **Entry Fee** : The entry fee is £15 per boat (cheques only).
- 7) **Sailing Instructions** : Sailing Instructions will be emailed to competitors prior to the event. A limited number of copies will be available at Registration.

8) **Schedule** :

Registration :	From 09:00 to 10:00
Briefing :	09:30
First Warning Signal (morning) :	10:20
Lunch break ashore :	From approximately 12.30
Prize giving :	Approximately 16:30

It is intended to run a 4 race series during which there will be a break ashore for lunch. Races will be approximately 40 minutes duration for the leading boats. The Race Officer may vary the number and duration of races at his/her discretion.

Provided that there are at least 5 entries for each rig then there will be separate starts for Pro and Sport fleets and results will be calculated separately; otherwise a combined series will be held.

Any changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board at least 30 minutes before.

- 9) **Courses** : Courses will be explained during the briefing and displayed on the Committee Boat.
- 10) **Scoring** : RRS Appendix A – Low Point Scoring System will be used. One race will constitute a series. If less than three races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. Otherwise her series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11) **Support Boats** : No support boats other than those owned and operated by FPSC are allowed to launch on Frensham Great Pond.
- 12) **Prizes** : Separate prizes will be awarded as advised at the time.
- 13) **Catering** : The galley will be open from 09:00 until 17:00. The entry fee includes lunch and a hot dog after racing for all entrants. **Supporters requiring lunch should book and pay for it at Registration.**
- 14) **Dogs** : Are welcome but they must be kept on a lead at all times when not in a vehicle and are not allowed in the Clubhouse (guide dogs excepted). Owners must remove and dispose of any fouling.
